Channing Joseph, a writer and editor at The New York Times, is joining The Associated Press' San Francisco bureau.

Joseph will be the bureau's night breaking news staffer, reporting on Northern California spot news as it develops. He starts Oct. 7.

The appointment was announced Monday by West Region Editor Traci Carl.

"Channing brings a unique mix of reporting and editing skills to an important bureau, and we are thrilled to have him join the staff in San Francisco," Carl said.

Joseph has been at the Times since 2010, serving most recently as a staff editor on the Metro copy desk while also regularly serving as a reporter on the Continuous News Desk. He also worked as an editor on various other copy desks, including National/Foreign, Business, Features and Sports. He regularly contributed articles on topics ranging from local crime to national politics to the mood at Whitney Houston's childhood church on the Sunday after her death.

During his decade-long journalism career he has written for many publications, including The New York Sun, Vibe, Entertainment Weekly, The Atlantic and Publishers Weekly. Before joining the Times, Joseph was a visiting professor at the State University of New York in Plattsburgh, where he taught undergraduate courses in beat reporting, magazine writing and entertainment journalism.

Joseph earned his undergraduate degree from Oberlin College and received a master's in journalism from Columbia University.
